The U.S. remained neutral for the first year and a half of the war. Then, on March 11, 1941, U.S. President Franklin Delano Roosevelt signed the Lend-Lease Act, authorizing U.S. ships to carry supplies across the Atlantic Ocean to Britain and other countries fighting the Axis Powers.
